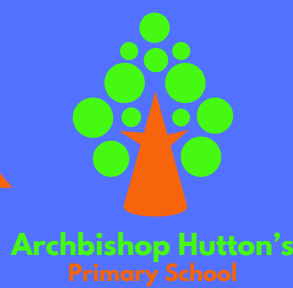

As it is the last day, everyone can come to school in non-uniform or party clothes.



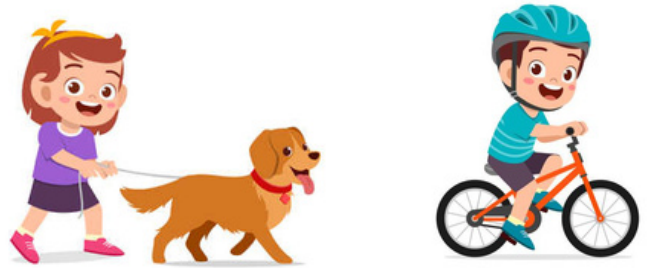

Next Term's Exciting Events

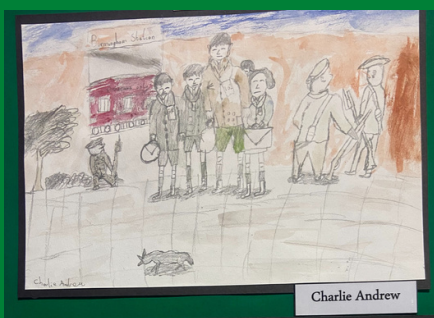


As you know, we are always busy in school and we have lots of exciting events lined up for the children over the Spring Term.

Class 4 study Wartime Art

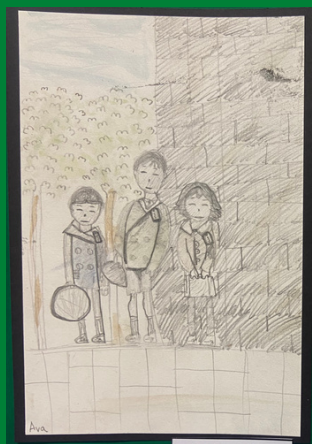

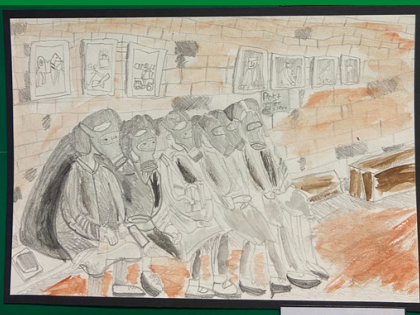
