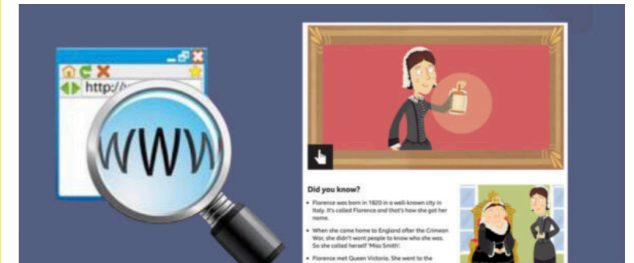


? What are we learning about internet research?

The internet can be used to learn and find the information. We need to make sure we are only using websites that can help us and are suitable. It is important we read the web-pages carefully to find the information and use the images, videos and interactive activities, if there are any, to learn more.

📖 Key knowledge

1. Understand how a web-page displays information in different ways; text, images, videos and interactive elements.
2. Use a web-page to answer questions by using keywords.



💡 Quick tips

- Look for the keywords in the question and see if you can find them on the web-page to help you find the answer.
- When watching an information video, use the controls to pause the videos and go back to watch it again if needed. Also use the video transcript to read the video information too.
- Use the find tool within the internet browser to search for the keywords on the web-page.

📖 Important Vocabulary

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| Internet browser | A piece of software used to view websites. |
| Web-page | A web-page is a page of information on the internet that is part of a website. |
| Keywords | These are important words from a question or the information. For example, in the question <i>'What clothes did the Vikings wear?'</i> The keywords would be <i>vikings</i> and <i>clothes</i> . |
| Video transcript | This is a written version of a video's voiceover and means you can read the information from a video as well as hear and see it. |
| Bullet points | Information written down as a list to make it easier to understand. The quick tips above are written as bullet points. |
