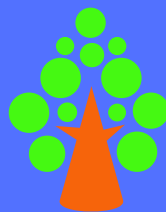

The last week of term will be our annual Science Week. This year the focus will be investigating and electricity.

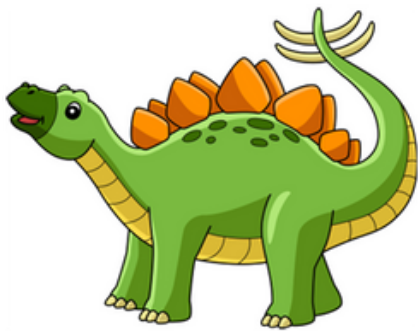
Here are three challenges for Science Week. Please choose one of the challenges and bring your work on Dress Like A Scientist Day (Thursday 25th)
