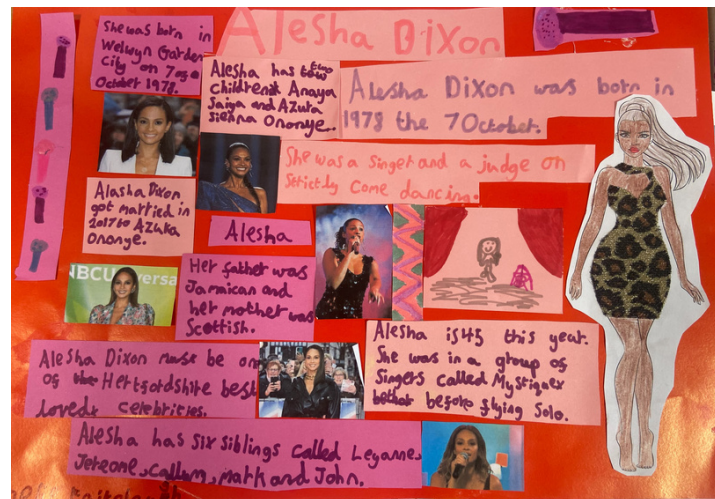


Black History Week Celebration
