**Breaking Bread at St Oswalds**

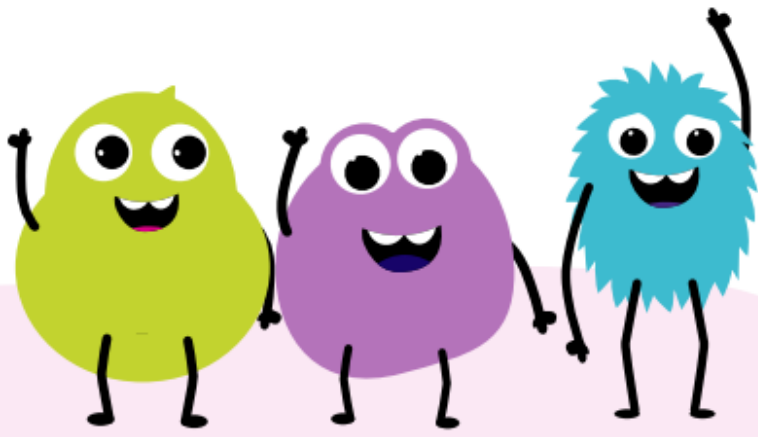

Class One have explored nature. They have made seed covered fat balls to hang in the trees and feed the birds that visit our school grounds.



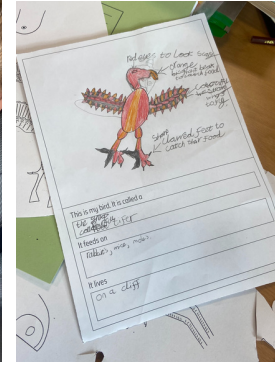
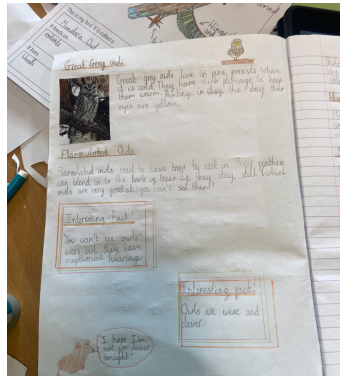
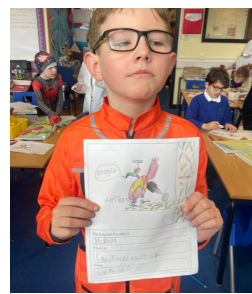
### **Teabag Babies**
