## Mental Health - Getting on and falling out

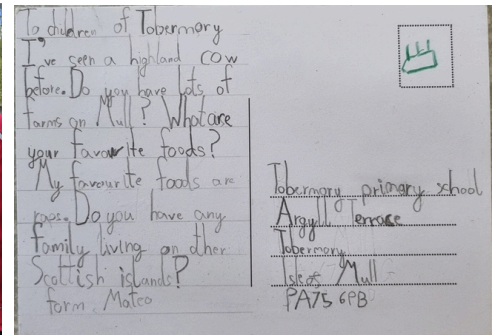
In our assembly time, we have been thinking about the importance of truthfulness, kindness and feelings.
