On Tuesday, we received this year's SAT results. They are displayed in this table:

We are delighted with these scores as they show an increase from the last two years and we are above the national average in all areas. They also highlight the hard work of the children and all of the staff who have taught them across school, especially Mr McGurk, whose hard work in the last two years has ensured the children's success. We are also delighted that our 93% of our Y1 pupils achieved their Phonics level and all of Y4 scored either 24 or 25 (out of 25) in their multiplication assessment.
