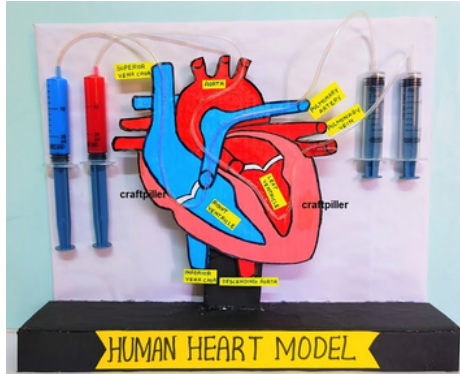


# Lots of Science Project ideas
